



Canada-Europe Transatlantic Dialogue



The **Canada-Europe Transatlantic Dialogue** (CETD) brings together scholars and partner organizations to promote research on relations between Canada and the European Union, as well as on policy challenges of their common concern.

We foster Canada-wide and trans-Atlantic research networks, and disseminate research findings to the Canadian policy community and to the public at large. Our aim is to enhance the quality of public discourse and to encourage research-based assessments of diverse responses to pressing policy problems.

Our work is organized around five Thematic Research Groups (TRGs):

- The EU and Canada as Global Actors in International Conflict Management and Security
- “Democratic Deficits” and Policy Coordination in Multi-Level Governance Systems
- Immigration and Social Policy
- Economic Cooperation, Competition, and International Law
- Environment and Sustainable Development

The project is housed at Carleton University in Ottawa. Leading scholars from four Canadian universities joined Carleton to launch the project: the Universities of British Columbia, Montréal and Victoria, and McGill University. These partner universities also contribute to the funding of the project.
